



CASA SCREENING AGREEMENT

The CASA Volunteer application, interviews and training are all part of our mutual screening process. The reason why this volunteer position is so exclusive is because the stakes are so high. Our agency's priority is to ensure effective advocacy for children.

If we believe that your placement with CASA is not a good fit, we will let you know in one of two ways. If we have concerns that can be specifically addressed, we will discuss these concerns with you. If we believe our concerns cannot be specifically addressed, we will let you know that we are unable to retain you as a volunteer. Unfortunately, we are not able to share specifics regarding these decisions with candidates.

Likewise, if you come to believe that being a CASA volunteer is not a good fit for you, or you are not able to make the commitment required, you are free to withdraw from the application and training process at any time.

You should be aware that our training could **potentially trigger** unresolved emotional or psychological issues. If you have unresolved issues that could influence your ability to maintain an open and neutral position in advocating for children we would ask that you **take this into consideration when taking on this challenge.**
